For those moving abroad

Don't forget to pay your resident tax!



Even if you move abroad in the middle of the fiscal year, you will still be levied individual inhabitant tax for that year, and if you move after January 2nd but before the tax payment notice is sent, you will also be levied the following year.

Before you leave Japan, you must complete one of the following two procedures!

Appoint a Tax Agent (Nozei Kanrinin)

If you are unable to receive notices and pay your taxes due to moving out, please appoint a tax agent before moving out. A tax agent will act as your agent to pay taxes and receive refunds.

lump-sum collection (Ikkatsu Choshu)

If you have individual inhabitant tax deducted (special collection) from your monthly salary and you leave your company, you can have the remaining tax amount deducted in a lump sum from your final salary or retirement benefits.

If you are retiring between June and December and would like your tax to be collected in a lump sum, please let your company know. If you are retiring after January, your tax will generally be collected in a lump sum.
